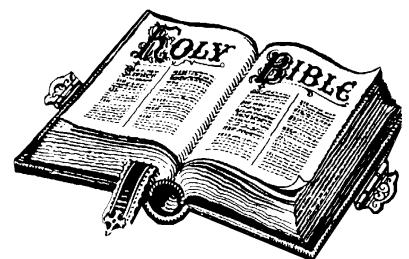
Spiritual transformation is the process by which Christ is formed in us, that's the key to Intentional transformation. How well we cope with summer

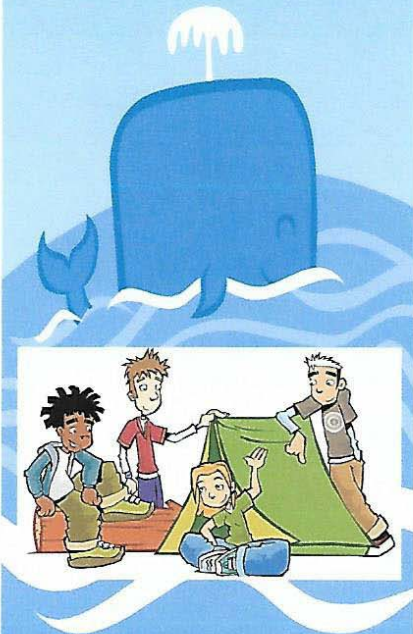
