
Romans 12:1-2 NRSV

Jeremiah the prophet had some ferocious enemies, and before they could get out of bed and begin their evil irresponsible work, the Lord was on His field of duty providing a way and a means for Jeremiah to carry out God's task. In the coldest circumstances of a prophet's life God is wide awake: "**He that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.**" Colossians 1:13 states, "God has rescued us from the power for darkness;" by loving us, watching over us and helping us to transform our lives into the image of Christ. Therefore, believe . . . God is on His job delivering us from the power of Satan, our enemies and our self at times so that we conform not to this world,

but become transformed by having our minds renewed in Christ daily. (Ephesians 4:23)

This is my point: Our God is wide-awake. He looks out upon our wintry circumstances where nothing can hide from His sight. There is no unrecognized and uncounted factor which may secretly steal and take Him by surprise. Everything is open to Him. He is wide-awake on the far-off field where the isolated missionary is ploughing his lonely furrow; He is wide-awake on the field of common labor where some young disciple finds it hard to keep clean hands while he earns his daily bread. God is always alert and watching, the almond tree is one of many signs God has given us as reminders that His presence is significance in our lives. And our transformation is important to Him as followers of Christ.
